(a) Old Residents: Those of our members or their next generation present descendants who are settled and continuously living in Mumbai for the past 51(fifty one) years (i.e., since 1st January, 1970 or before) are welcome to be enlisted in this category. TECH TALK BY MR UDAY MATHUR

TechBox -Presenting my two bits (..and bytes.) A continuing feature in this publication, with interesting tidbits for easy usage of smartphones & laptops. To interest members of all age groups.

Use voice message feature instead of physically typing text! It is very convenient for WhatsApp and SMS use on your smartphone.

On any smartphone, go to WhatsApp and to the New Message page where one would normally go to type a new message, or respond to a sender. Look for the microphone icon on the bottom right side of the display. Press the icon and keep it pressed while you dictate your message. Immediately on releasing, it will be automatically sent off as a voice note.

When using SMS, this is a bit different. After ensuring that the recipient is mentioned in the 'To:' window, bring the cursor to the write message window. Tap the message icon once and dictate your message. Then see the message you just dictated and correct errors, if any. Then, tap the send arrow to transmit the message.

You will find this common feature extremely useful!
