11. MAB FUNCTIONS: One Central and one Zonal Function each year

So far MAB has been holding two Central functions, one in April (Holi) and the other in December (Diwali) each year. However, the catering expenses and venue-hire charges are rising steeply for the last few years. On the other hand our income from interest on FD's and Savings Account (our main, rather only, source of regular income) has been greatly reduced of late due to drastic cuts in Bank interest rates. Non-receipt of annual membership (Rs.75 per member) from a large number of members adds further to this problem. Though we do occasionally receive some donations / sponsorships once in a while, these are unpredictable and can not be anticipated for budgeting our functions. With its present financial position as above, MAB is now finding it difficult to hold two Central functions a year (invariably going in substantial deficit) as it has somehow managed so far.

After a careful consideration of the problem in consultation with our SZR's (in the joint meeting held on 9.11.03) the Managing Committee has decided as follows:

- A. From the year 2004 onwards MAB will have only one Central function in December each year for all members from Mumbai and all suburbs. Details and arrangements of this function will generally be the same as at present.
- B. MAB may organize a central Monsoon picnic if the Zonal Committees desire and come forward to support it so as to be a self-financed event.
- C. Each Zone will organize at least one Zonal get-together a year in its own Zone, aiming at maximum participation of the Zonal members. This will also serve the dual purpose of better and closer interaction between the families in a Zone. Zonal Committees will decide suitable dates for their functions, taking care that these do not clash with the dates of the Central Function / picnic.
