IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Old residents and Senior Citizens among Mumbai Mathurs:

In celebration of its Golden Jubilee Year (2020), MAB, in its next Newsletter (and also in the new Directory, if possible) proposes to recognize and honour its old members and biradri buzurgs as follows:

(a) **Old Residents:** Those of our members or their next generation present descendants who are settled and continuously living in Mumbai for the past 51(fifty one) years (i.e., since 1st January, 1970 or before) are welcome to be enlisted in this category. They may kindly let us have their names and address along with their date / year of settling in Mumbai. The date (even approx. will do) will be required to put their names in order of precedence. The period of 51 years has been chosen to identify them as being our members since even before the Association was formally founded 50 years ago, hence becoming a sort of 'founding members' of the 1970 formally founded Association.

(b) **Senior Citizens:**

About a decade ago a list of Seniors amongst Mathurs in Mumbai was compiled and it is now proposed that a list of our Seniors (ladies and gents of age 80 and above as on 1st January, 2020, living normally in Mumbai) be compiled afresh. Members who are of 80 or above themselves, (or their other family members having such elders, parents etc. of that age living with them) may please inform us their names and actual age for compilation of the list. Though proof of age is not required, birth year may be mentioned to determine and declare the senior most and others age wise in serial order.
